THE CREED

(Please stand)

**We believe in one God, The Father, the Almighty,
maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.
We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God,
eternally begotten of the Father, God from God,
Light from Light, true God from true God,**

begotten, not made,

**of one Being with the Father;
through Him all things were made.**

**For us and for our salvation He came down from heaven,
was incarnate from the Holy Spirit
and the Virgin Mary and was made Man.**

**For our sake He was crucified under Pontius Pilate;
He suffered death and was buried.**

**On the third day He rose again
in accordance with the Scriptures;**

**He ascended into heaven
and is seated at the right hand of the Father.**

**He will come again in glory
to judge the living and the dead,
and His Kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father (and the Son),**

**Who with the Father and the Son
is worshipped and glorified,**

Who has spoken through the prophets.

**We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church.
We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins.**

**We look for the resurrection of the dead,
and the life of the world to come. Amen.**

THE PEACE

The peace of the Lord be always with you

PREPARATION OF THE ALTAR

(We stand)

Blessed are You, Lord God of all creation:
through Your goodness we have this bread to set before
You, which earth has given and human hands have made.
It will become for us the bread of life.

Blessed be God for ever.

Blessed are You, Lord God of all creation:
through Your goodness
we have this wine to set before You,
fruit of the vine and work of human hands.
It will become for us the cup of salvation.

Blessed be God for ever.

The Lord is here: **His Spirit is with us.**
Lift up your hearts: **We lift them to the Lord.**
Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is indeed right, it is our duty and our joy,
at all times and in all places to give You thanks and praise,
Holy Father, heavenly King, almighty and eternal God.

For He is our great high priest,
Who has loosed us from our sins
and has made us to be a royal priesthood to You,
our God and Father.

Therefore with angels and archangels,
and with all the company of heaven,
we proclaim Your great and glorious name,
for ever praising You, and *saying*:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,
heaven and earth are full of Your glory.
Hosanna in the highest.
Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**

THE PRAYER OF CONSECRATION

Almighty God, our heavenly Father,
Who, in Your tender mercy, gave Your only Son our Saviour
Jesus Christ to suffer death upon the Cross for our
redemption; Who made there by His one oblation of Himself
once offered a full, perfect and sufficient sacrifice,
oblation and satisfaction for the sins of the whole world;
He instituted, and in His Holy Gospel commanded us
to continue, a perpetual memory of His precious death
until He comes again.

Hear us, merciful Father, we humbly pray,
and grant that we receiving these gifts of Your creation,
this bread and this wine, according to Your Son
our Saviour Jesus Christ's holy institution,
in remembrance of His death and passion,
may be partakers of His most blessed Body and Blood;

Who, in the same night that He was betrayed,
took bread and gave You thanks; He broke it
and gave it to His disciples, saying:
Take, eat, this is My Body which is given for you;
do this in remembrance of Me.

In the same way, after supper, He took the cup;
and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying:
Drink this, all of you, this is My Blood of the New Covenant,
which is shed for You and for many for the forgiveness of sins.
Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.
Amen.

Great is the mystery of faith:
Christ has died: Christ is risen: Christ will come again.

Therefore, Lord and heavenly Father, in remembrance of the
precious death and passion, the mighty resurrection
and glorious ascension of Your dear Son Jesus Christ,
we offer You through Him
this our sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving.
Grant that by His merits and death, and through faith in His
Blood, we and all Your Church may receive forgiveness of our
sins and all other benefits of His passion.

Although we are unworthy, through our manifold sins,
to offer You any sacrifice, yet we pray that You will accept
this the duty and service that we owe.

Do not weigh our merits, but pardon our offences,
and fill us all who share in this Holy Communion with Your
grace and heavenly blessing; through Jesus Christ our Lord,
by Whom, and with Whom, and in Whom,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honour and glory be Yours,
Almighty Father, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

THE LORD'S PRAYER

**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name;
Thy Kingdom come; Thy will be done;
on earth as it is in Heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses,
as we forgive those who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil.
For Thine is the Kingdom, the power
and the glory, for ever and ever. Amen.**

merciful Lord, trusting in our own righteousness,
but in Your manifold and great mercies.
We are not worthy so much as to gather up the crumbs
under Your table. But You are the same Lord
Whose nature is always to have mercy.
Grant us therefore, gracious Lord, so to eat the flesh of
Your dear Son Jesus Christ and to drink His Blood,
that our sinful bodies may be made clean by His Body,
and our souls washed through His most precious Blood,
and that we may evermore dwell in Him, and He in us.
Amen.**
